

Princeton Elm Ulmus americana

Category: Deciduous **Growth Rate**: Rapid

Adaptability: Full sun, light shade

Shape: Vase shaped, broad-rounded crown

Size: 50-70' tall, 30-50' wide

Fall Color: Insignificant yellow

Description: 'Princeton' reportedly has excellent resistance

to Dutch elm disease. Non-showy, small green flowers appear in spring before the foliage emerges. Leaves

typically turn yellow in fall. Used as a lawn, shade or street
