

Overcup Oak Quercus lyrata

Category: Deciduous Growth Rate: Medium Adaptability: Full sun Shape: Round to Oval

Size: 40-60' tall, 40-60' wide

Fall Color: Yellow-brown, sometimes orange and red

Description: Overcup Oak gets is name from the distinctive bur-like acorn that encloses 2/3 to almost all of the nut. Acorns do not appear until they reach 25-30 yeas old. Large shade tree or lawn tree. Slightly shaggy gray to grayish-brown bark on mature trees is reminiscent of the White Oak.
