Growth Rate: Moderate

Adaptability: Full sun to partial shade

Shape: Oval and rounded crown

Size: up to 30' tall, 25-35' wide

Flower/Fall Color: Bell-shaped white flowers, yellow in fall

Wildlife Value: Squirrels use for food and shelter

Description: A native featuring drooping clusters of bell-shaped, white flowers (1/2") which appear in spring.

Attractive, small tree or large shrub for woodland garden or border. Interesting specimen for the lawn. Grows well with rhododendrons and azaleas.
