

Elderberry Sambucus nigra

Category: Deciduous Growth Rate: Fast

Adaptability: Full sun for best flowering

Shape: Multi-stemmed, rounded

Size: 10-20' tall, 8-20' wide

Flower/Fall: Cream/white flowers give way to edible fruit **Wildlife Value:** Flowers attract butterflies, fruit attract birds

Description: Plant in moist, high organic matter, well-drained soil, though it tolerates a wide range of soils. Small multistemmed tree. Flowers are used to make wines and cordial and the berries can be made into jam and syrup. Plant multiple cultivars to increase fruit yield.
