

Honey Locust Gleditsia tricanthos

Category: Deciduous **Growth Rate**: Rapid

Adaptability: Full sun in well-drained, moist soil high in organic

matter. Does not grow as tall in partial shade.

Size: 60'-80' tall and 60'-80' wide

Fall Color: Feathery leaves turn gold/yellow in the fall

Wildlife Value: Bean pods provide food for wildlife, flowers attract pollinators, larval host plant for Silver-spotted Skipper.

Description: Excellent choice to plant in a native garden or as a street or security tree. Trunk and branches have stout thorns.
