

Pecan Carla illinoensis

Category: Deciduous
Growth Rate: Medium

Adaptability: Full sun to partial shade, best grown in full sun

Shape: Uniform, symmetrical, broadly oval crown

Size: 70-100' tall, 40-75' wide

Value: Nuts are edible, larval host plant to the Luna moth

Description: A native tree grown mostly for its edible nuts that appear in summer. Tolerates clay, sand, loam in well drained soils. While pecans are monoecious (have separate male and female flowers on the same tree), for optimal pollination, plant at least three different cultivars.
