

Kobai Japanese Apricot

Prunus mume 'Kobai'



Category: Deciduous

Growth Rate: Average

Adaptability: Full sun for best flowering

Shape: Upright, rounded and vase shaped

Size: 15-20' tall, 15-20' wide

Flowers: Fragrant, red, semi-double flowers

Description: Japanese apricot is primarily ornamental, and noted for its mid to late winter bloom of pink flowers. Fruits ripen in summer and are technically edible fresh, but are of poor quality in comparison to common apricots.
